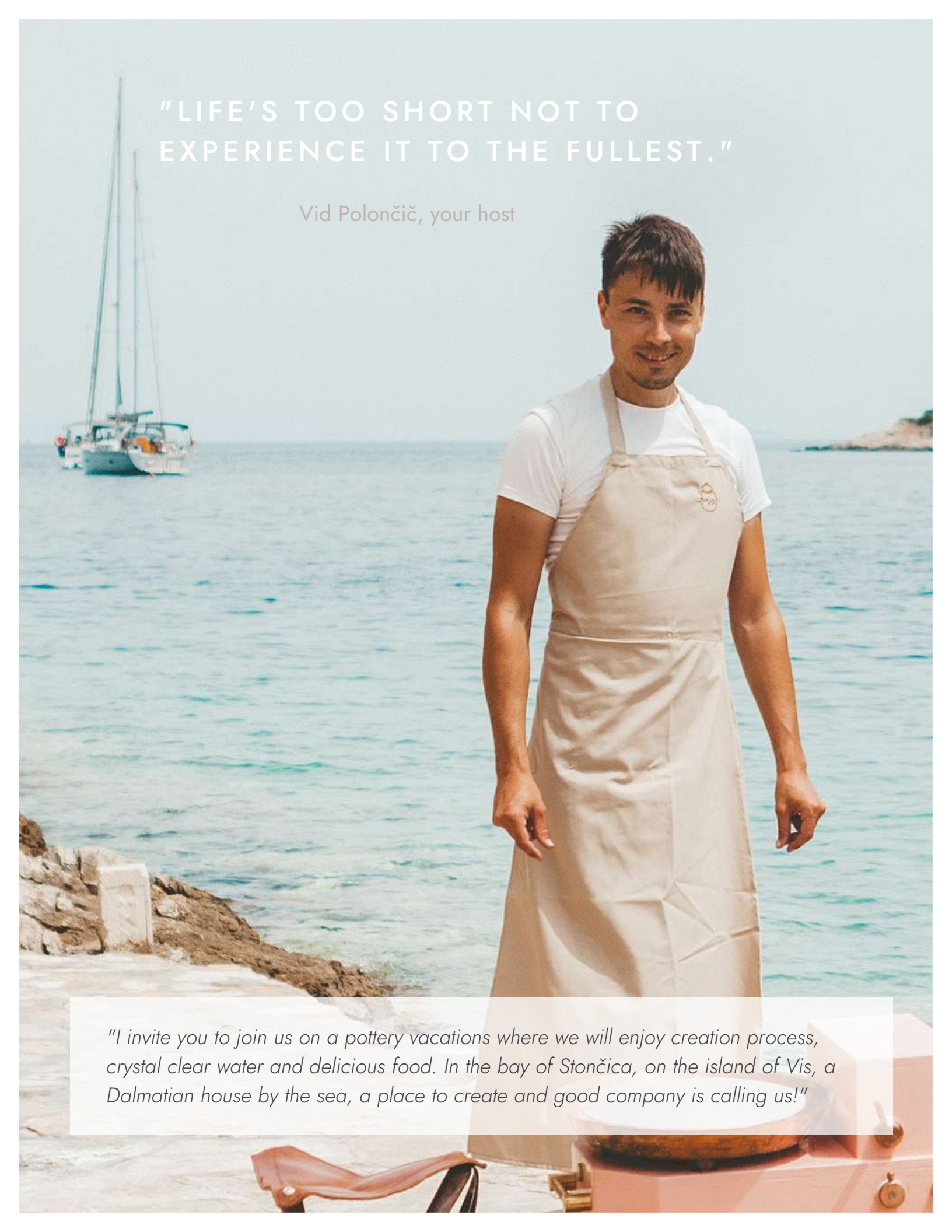

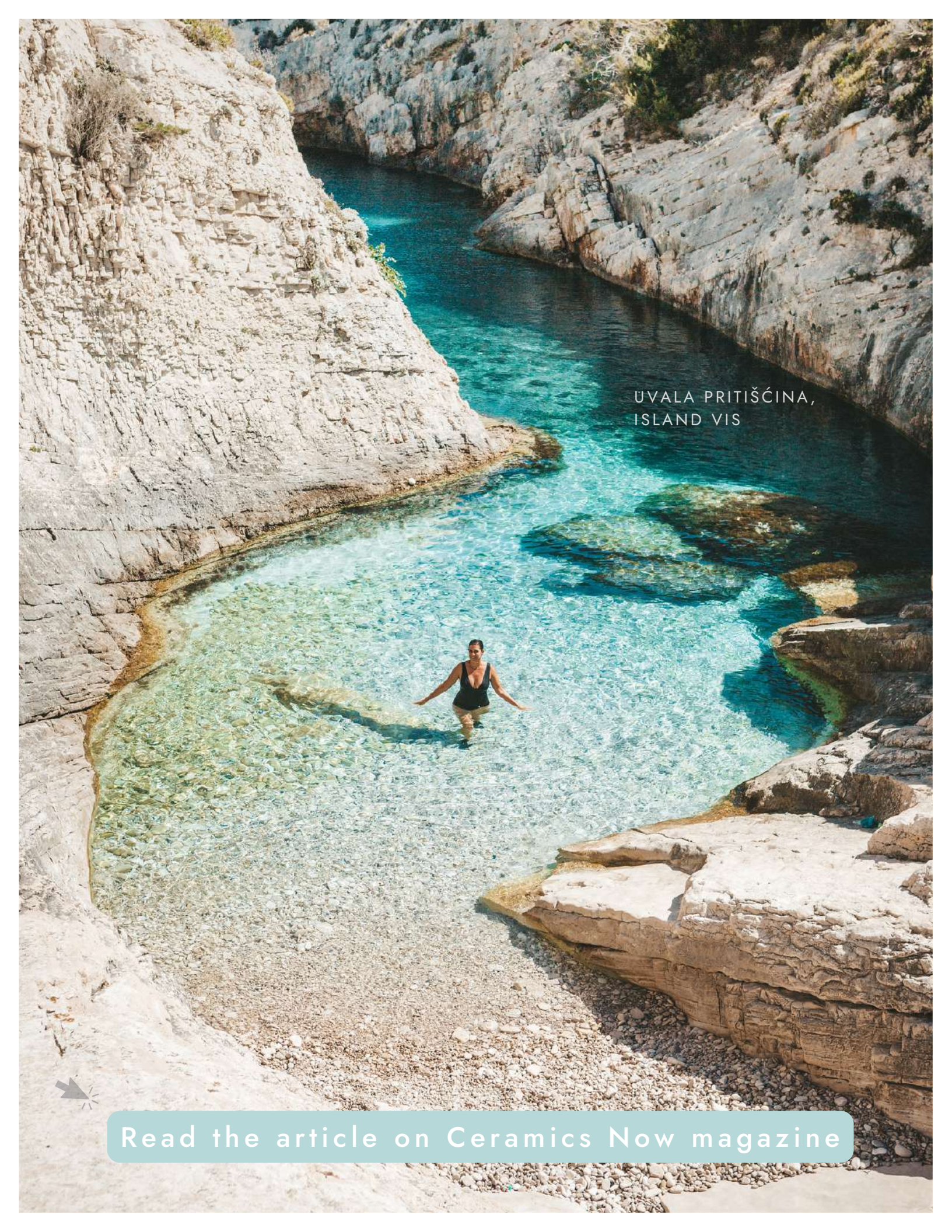

At the workshop, we will deal with the optimization of the process of work on the potter's wheel, learn how to achieve the best results with basic pottery tools and improve the throwing of the clay by improving the technique. The workshop will take place outdoors, and in case of rain or heavy sun on the covered terrace. It is also suitable for those who will be meeting the potter's wheel for the first time.

- kneading
- centering
- opening
- pulling
- finishing, rims and handles
- decorating
- trimming
- drying (but without firing)

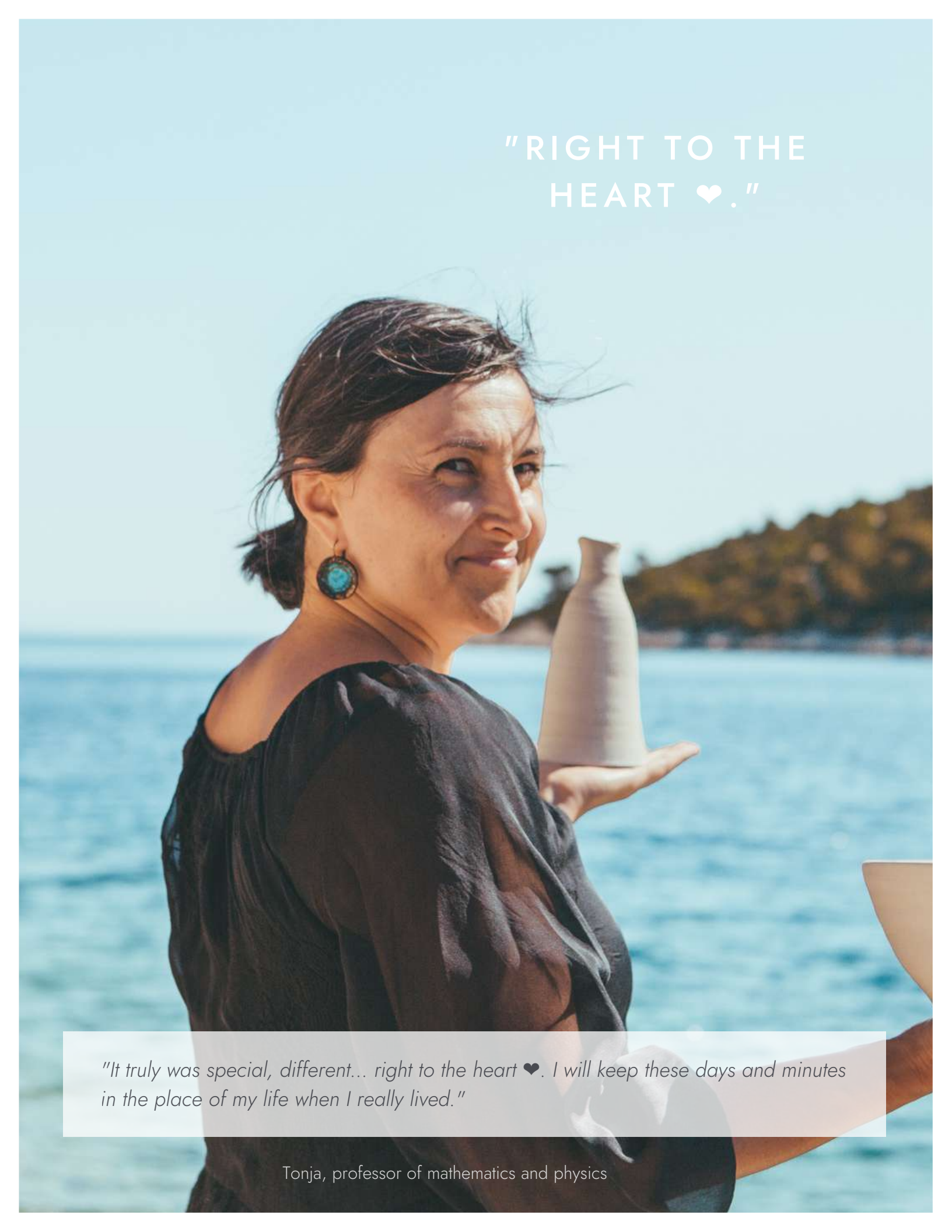
TRADITIONAL TECHNIQUES

The emphasis will be on techniques that originate from the Slovenian tradition, as over the generations the work with clay on the potter's wheel has developed to such an extent that it offers simple and effective solutions.

- centering, opening and pulling with leather
- use of basic tools
- pots upgrading
- features of making different shapes

PAYMENT AND REGISTRATION

When you register for the island Vis pottery vacations, you will receive a pro forma invoice. By paying the pro forma invoice, you are guaranteed participation in the workshop. Payment is possible in two or more monthly instalments by prior agreement. In case of a larger number of applications, priority will be given to those who will be the first to pay the registration fee.

CANCELLATION POLICY

If you are to cancel up to two months in advance you get a full refund*.

If you are to cancel up to one month in advance you get 50% refund*.

No refund is given to those who cancel within one month before the start of the workshop.

YOGA AND NATURAL COSMETICS PRODUCTION

YOGA PRACTICE

I am a yoga instructor with just a short period of teaching yoga on the island. Our practice will be based on my own genuine experience and approach to what I learned about yoga until now and I welcome all of you. We will be connecting to our bodies, aligning our postures, slowly waking up in the mornings and preparing ourselves for the day. Evening yoga practice will be devoted to exploring our inner state and being. We will be observing and calming our mind flow, finding comfort in our asanas and reaching out to stay in a meditative state for a while.

Duration - 90 minutes

Fee - 75 EUR/full retreat (yogamat and accessories included)

HOMEMEDE SOAP WORKSHOP

Women used to do soaps from wood ash and animal fat. Today we use different types of plant oils and lye. Natural soap making is approximately a 2-4 hours long process although the soaps we will make can not be used for another month. The saponification process takes time. To make a long process a bit shorter, we will be making homemade salt soaps.

Duration - 4 hours

Fee - 70 EUR (all materials included)
